- **NUMBER**: 1
- **VALUE:** \$600
- **TENURE:** A music program or music education program at any recognized North American post-secondary institution.
- CRITERIA:1. Applicant has fulfilled the Grade 12 graduation requirements with an "A" in all grade 11 and 12 music courses and intends to pursue a career in music education, teaching music in the schools.
 - 2. An active participant in school music programs class and performing ensemble.
 - 3. A member in at least one of the following: concert band, concert choir, string orchestra; and preferably, additional membership in jazz band and/or vocal jazz.
 - 4. A good citizen.
 - 5. In the case of equal qualifications, preference may be given to a student who has participated in community organizations such as cadets, church, guides, scouts etc.
- DEADLINE: May 4, 2018 The deadline may be extended by the Scholarship Representative

- **PROCEDURE:** 1. Obtain application form for Greater Victoria Scholarships from the School Scholarship Representative or Career Centre.
 - 2. Submit the completed application to the School Scholarship Representative. Include with the application:
 - a) A statement outlining the applicant's goals as a music educator.
 - b) A résumé.
 - b) A letter of recommendation from one, or preferably two, school music teachers.
 - c) A letter of recommendation from a non-music teacher.
 - d) A letter of recommendation from a non-related adult in the community.
 - e) If available, notice of post-secondary acceptance.
 - 3. Students do not need to include a transcript of marks as it will be added by the School Scholarship Representative once the Ministry of Education transcripts are available in August.

SELECTION INFORMATION:

The Greater Victoria School District Scholarship and Bursary Committee meets in the fall to choose the recipients of this award, once the Grade 12 Graduation Program Examinations results are available.
