

## Course Selection



# Choosing your Math 10

You passed Math 9/Math 9 Honours:

- 1. Foundations of Math & Pre-calculus 10 (A or B in Math 9 recommended 73% +) OR...
- 2. Workplace Math 10
- Check teacher's recommendation

## Choosing your Math 10

You took Math 9A and did well:

- a. Workplace Math 10 or
- b. Math 9, if you're hoping to continue with academic math, then plan on FMP10

## Choosing your Math 10

If you did not pass Math 9

- a. Summer school Math 9 (if offered)
- b. Choose Math 9 for next year
   Most likely follow with WMa10

#### Thinking about your Math...

What course did I do this year?
 Level? Mark? How hard was it?



- What do I need going forward?
   Graduation? After high school? Postsecondary pre-requisites?
- How hard am I willing to work?



#### Physical & Health Education 10

- 1. Physical & Health Education 10 (co-ed.) OR...
- 2. Physical & Health Education 10
  Fit for Life (curriculum designed to support health of students who identify as female)

#### Electives

- 1. Select three electives (FRIM students select 2)
- 2. Select 2 alternates
- 3. Select 1 or more outside-thetimetable elective(s) – in addition to your 8 – if you like



## **Choosing Electives**

- In general, choose gr. 10 electives unless you've already taken them
- Grade 11 academic courses (Science, Socials, English and Math) preference given to Grade 11 & 12 students
- Repeating a course: if you re-take the same course at the same grade level, you only earn credits once.

# Choosing Trades Electives

- If not, start at the grade 10 level.
