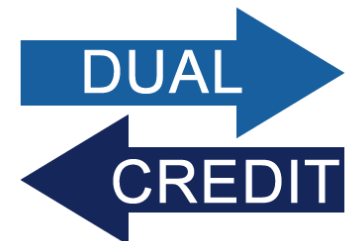

Dual Credit Courses

- **Ustart**

Applying in grade 11, students can pick from over 250 first and second year courses to take during their gr. 12 year

- **Camosun**

Students can take any first year course

- **School-Based Cohort Classes**

High school teachers team-teach with Camosun College instructors, providing students with the opportunity to earn dual credit right in their home school

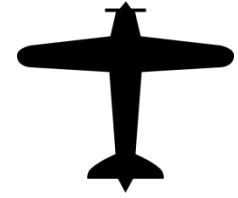
Youth **WORK** in Trades

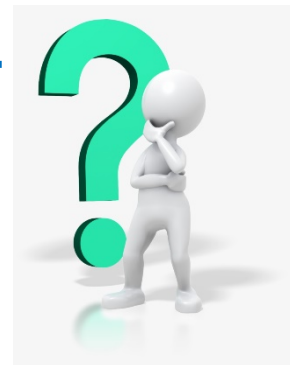

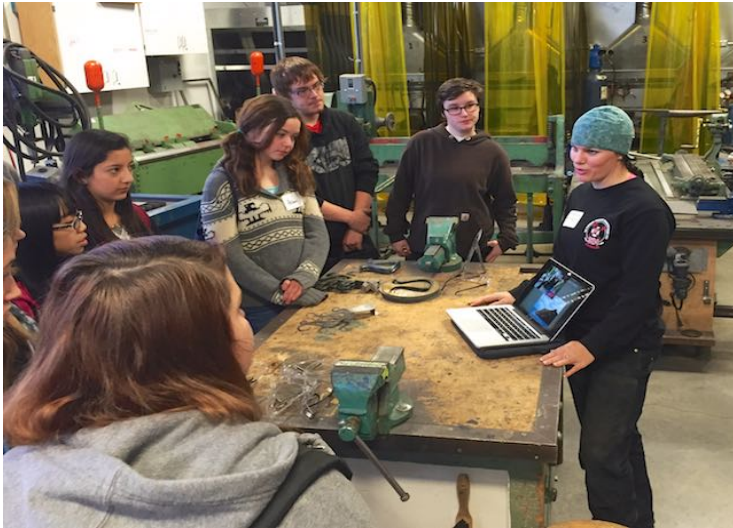
