

Choosing your Math 10

You passed Math 9...

- Foundations of Math & Pre-calculus
 10 (A or B in Math 9 recommended –
 73% +)

 OR...
- Workplace Math 10
- Check teacher's recommendation

Choosing your Math 10 cont'd...

If you <u>didn't</u> pass Math 9...

(Final mark - W or less than 50%)

- A. Select Math 9
- * To make sure you get Math 9, enter it on Line #4
- B. You may select a Math 10 as well—as one of your electives

Physical & Health Education 10

Electives

- 1. Select three electives (FRIM students select 2)
- 2. Select 2 alternates
- 3. Select 1 or more outside-thetimetable elective(s) – in addition to your 8 – if you like

Choosing Electives

- In general, choose gr. 10 electives unless you've already taken them
- Grade 11 academic courses (Science, Socials, English and Math) preference may be given to Grade 11 & 12 students
- Repeating a course: if you re-take the same course at the same grade level, you only earn credits once.
