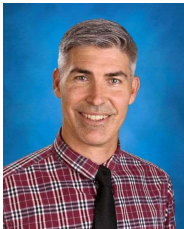

Vic High graduates have once again secured a record number of scholarships and bursaries to support them in their post-secondary pursuits.

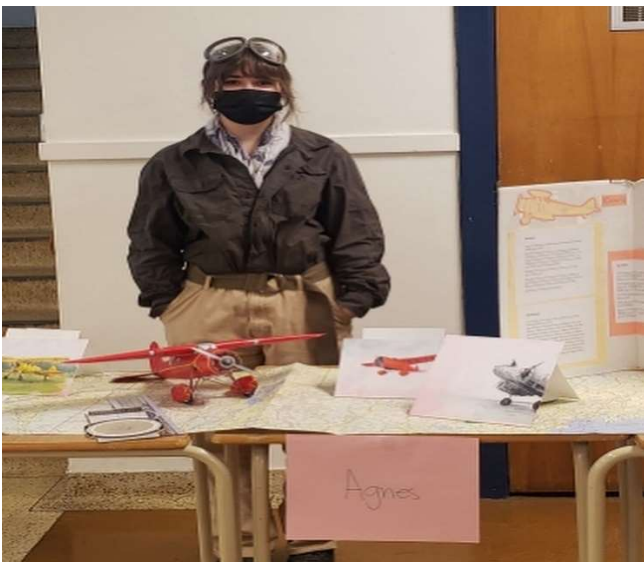
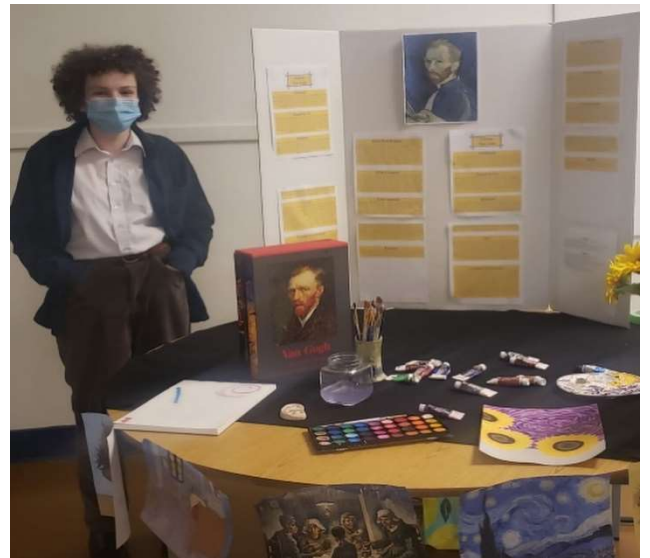
Thanks to the generous support of our community and the Alumni Association, Vic High proudly awards 54 scholarships — worth more than \$38,000 — directly to graduating students every year.

In addition to these scholarships, this year's grad class has won over \$410,000 in school district and community bursaries as well as post-secondary entrance scholarships.

In total, 93 scholarships/bursaries have been presented to 57 different graduates, for a total of over \$448,000. This means that more than 25% of our 2022 graduates have received financial support for their post-secondary aspirations.

The staff at Vic High wishes all of our graduates all the best in their future pursuits. We know that you will make us proud.

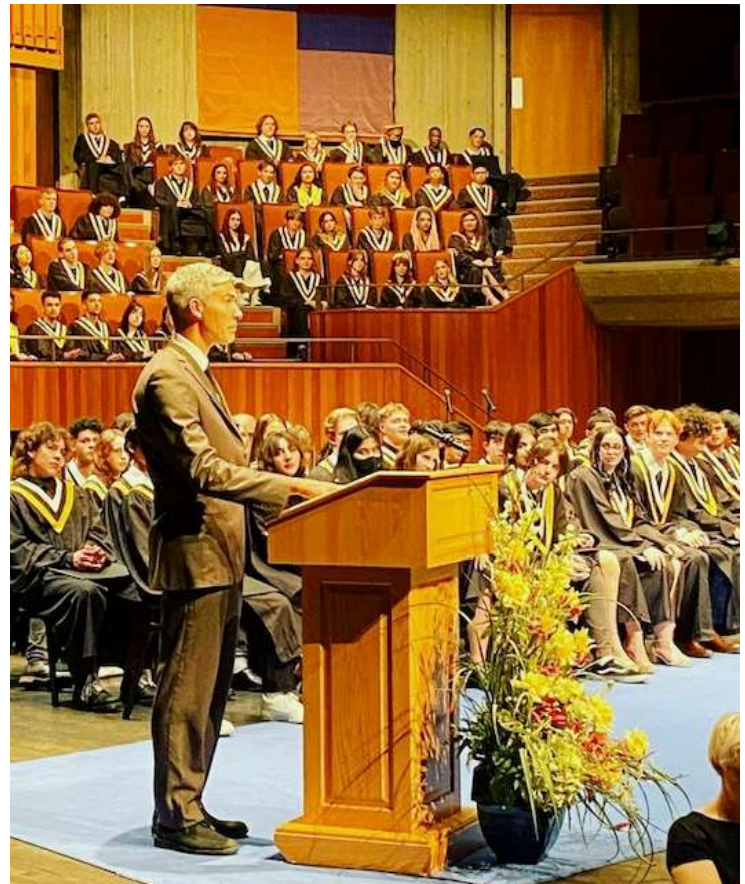
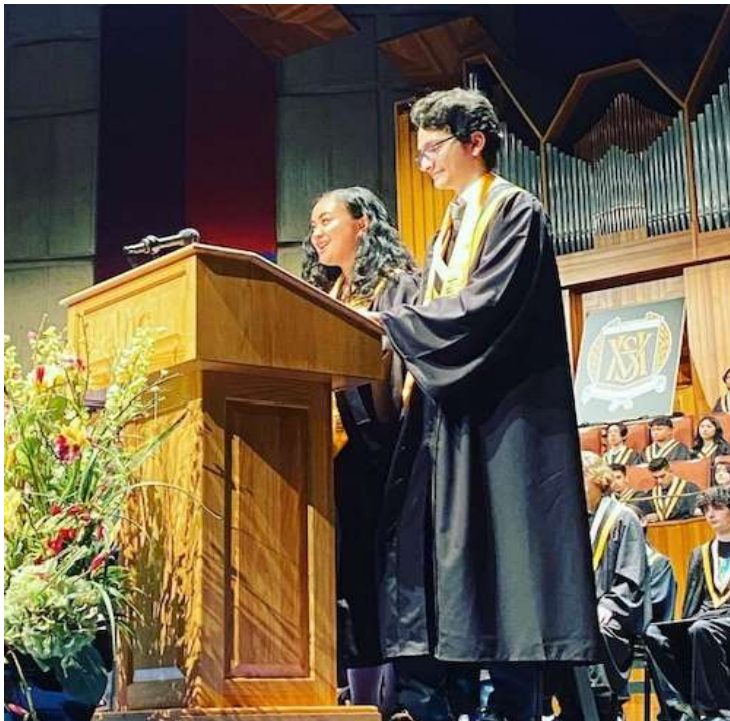
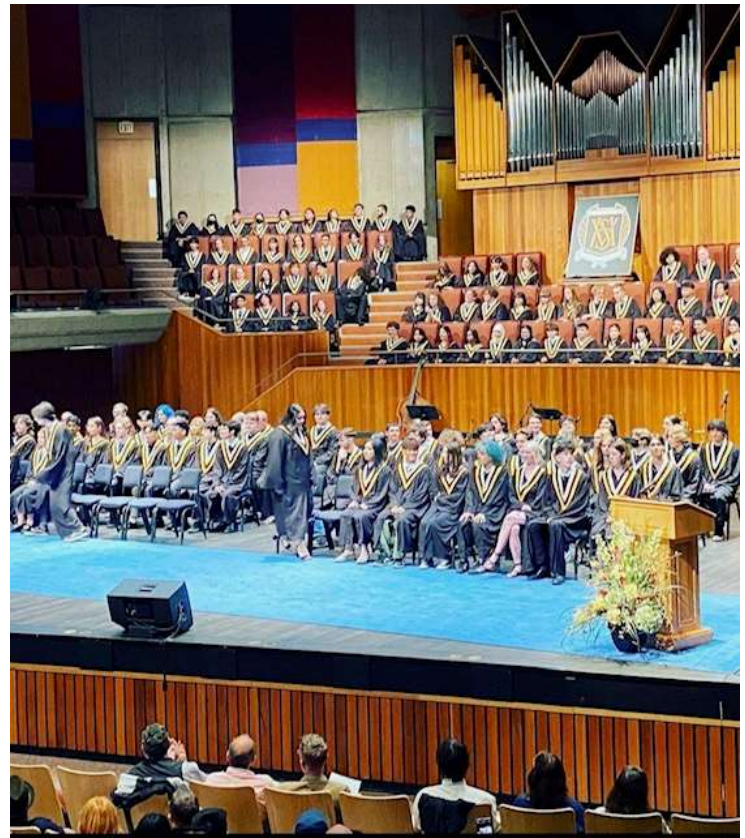

We will miss this amazing group of grads who have proven that heart and soul still permeate Vic High, even in these trying times.



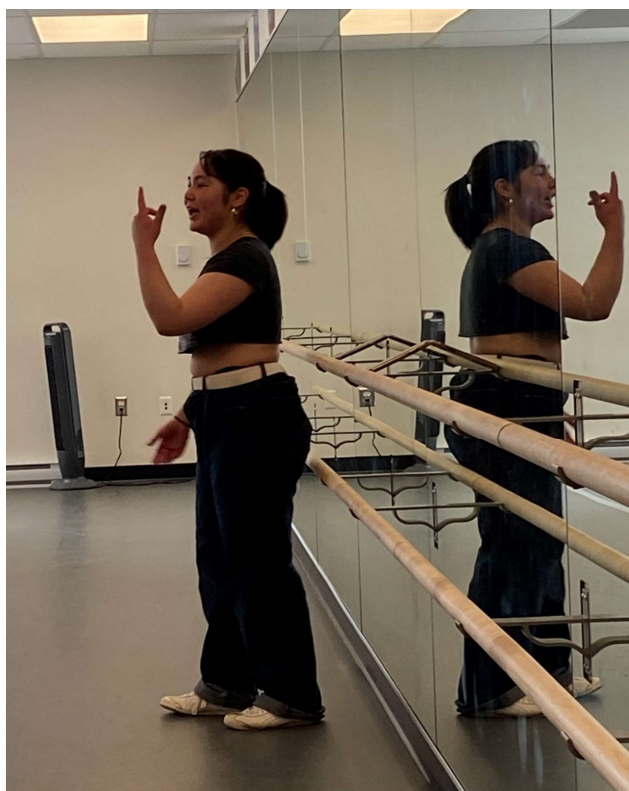

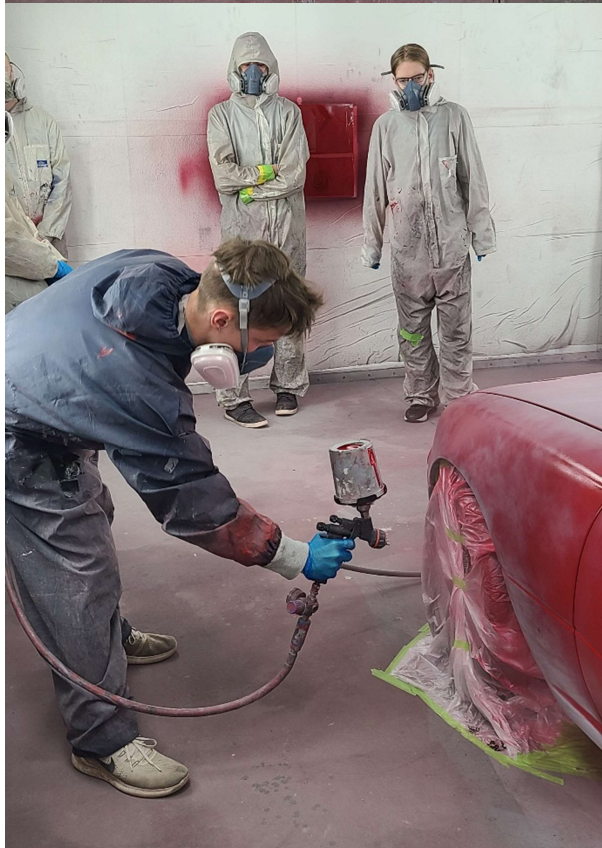

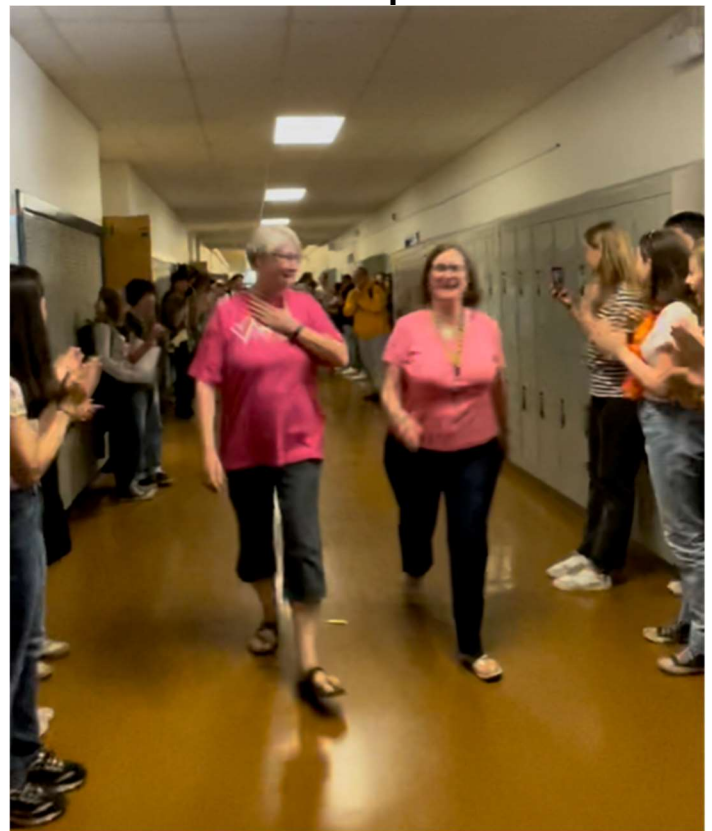
