Guest Speaker – Graeme Hamilton, School Counsellor began teaching career in 1996 on the Lower Mainland and then moved to Victoria in 2016. Started with Tech Ed and then moved into Counselling. He worked at Vic High from 2017-20 and is back now as Dept Head, working alongside fellow counsellor Paula Manning, the YFC (Youth and Family Counselling) team, and Samantha Spetter (career centre coordinator).

The school counsellors currently spend about 40% of their time on scheduling, 30% on mental health concerns, and 30% of their time working with Inclusive Learning Staff and assorted other duties.

YFC team has been hit with budget restraints and currently consists of 2.6 positions.

Would also like to work on Website Communication to get more information available to help families find resources in the community.
