Principal's Report (Aaron)

- School start up was a general success. Grade 9 orientation and class start up went relatively smoothly.
- Student incident in one of our grade 9 sessions.

- Student enrollment - Current enrollment at 857 – we anticipated 832 and were completely full at that size
- Athletics

 - Cross Country – first meet next week – still time to join
 - Boys Soccer – Lots of interest, almost 20 players trying out
 - Music Programs - still promoting sign up
- School Move

 - January 29 – School Based Pro D (no classes)
 - January 30 – Curriculum Completion (no classes)
 - January 31 – Semester Turn around (no classes)

Treasurer's Report (Kristine)

- Gaming Account
 - Waiting on Gaming Grant Funds (\$20/student). Estimated at \$16,000 revenue (~800 students)
 - Current balance - \$4018.34
 - Outstanding expense requests - (\$695)
 - Proposed Balance available - \$19,323.34
- General Account
 - Current Balance - \$7927.88
 - New School Expenses held in reserve- \$4000.00
 - Outstanding Cheque - \$210.00
 - Proposed balance available - \$3717.88
 - Most income comes from fundraising - Coffee. Perhaps poinsettias?
