- Working on Food Program 90-120 students participate (90 food insecure, 30 convenience). Budget supports Monday-Thursday only (no program on Fridays). 50% of the budget is already spent but we are not 50% through the school year. Miss Mercer runs the program. \$8.25/meal. Leadership program does breakfast while food program meals are organized/served by paid staff. Looking for a solution to expand to Fridays hoping to figure out solutions to raise funding.
- Arrange guest speakers Wellness Grant Nurses, Mental Health, Sexual Health,
- Other initiatives have bathroom doors re-installed.
- 2 new crosswalks across Grant at Camosun were in the original plan. Follow up requests have gone to the City of Victoria.
